

Carlisle Golf Team Rules/Guidelines

PLAYER EXPECTATIONS

1. Team members are required to attend all scheduled practices unless they have obtained prior approval (with parent notifying the coach).
2. Eligibility must be maintained throughout the school year.
3. Must display respect for the golf course and staff, your teammates, and coach.
4. You must strive for excellence daily.
5. You are expected to qualify for a match by posting a score during a previous practice.
6. Good behavior both to and from matches, plus during the match, is the expectation. Poor behavior will result in a consequence and the severity of the consequence will depend on the severity of the poor behavior.

PRACTICE / WORKOUT

- Use practice time well. Be efficient and productive. Get better today. Socialize afterwards.
- Obtain a copy of the rules of golf and keep it in your bag. Learn the rules and proper golf etiquette.
- When playing – hole out all putts, replace divots, pull and replace the flagstick carefully, repair ball marks on the green, rake sand traps, and play at a quick pace.
- Players are not allowed to ride in carts during team practice or matches. This includes any rounds of golf played for qualifying or for team practice.

RESPECT FOR FACILITIES AND STAFF

We are guests of the facilities that we are allowed to practice on. Team members should conduct themselves in an appropriate manner and be respectful to the employees and members of the facility. Remember, you will be associated with the team even during non-practice time so represent the team properly.

DRESS CODE

- Once a student has become a member of the team they must maintain a standard expected of athletes in our community.
- Proper golfing attire is required for practice on the range, putting green, qualifying rounds, or any other event that requires you to be at a facility for golf team purposes. This means wearing a collared shirt, no jeans or sandals. **Shirts must be tucked in at all times.**

I understand that to be part of the Carlisle golf team I must abide by these rules set forth by the golf coach. Any dissention from these rules will result in being released from the team.
