#### 102. ACADEMIC STANDARDS

## **Purpose**

The Board recognizes that education is a vital function of the state and community. The school community, through the strategic planning process, shall be encouraged to participate in the development of curriculum in alignment with academic standards. [1] [2] [3]

#### **Definition**

**Academic standards** - shall be defined as what a student should know and be able to do at a specified grade level; they shall describe the knowledge and skills students will be expected to demonstrate in order to graduate. Academic standards originate at the state or federal levels. [4] [5]

### **Authority**

The Board shall approve curriculum which is in alignment with state and/or federal academic standards. Curriculum and standards will govern instruction in the following content areas: [2] [6]

- 1. Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening.
- 2. Mathematics.
- 3. Science and Technology.
- 4. Environment and Ecology.
- 5. Social Studies to include history, geography, civics and government, and economics.
- 6. Arts and Humanities.
- 7. Career Education and Work.
- 8. Health, Safety and Physical Education.
- 9. Family and Consumer Science.
