125.	CONTINUING EDUCATION

1. Purpose

The Board recognizes the value of educational growth and advancement to adult members of the community and the need of both adults and minors for educational programs.

2. Authority SC 502, 1901, 1906

The Board shall establish a continuing education program which shall be made available to interested adults residing in the district.

Courses, instructors and locations shall be established by the continuing education office and approved by the Board each semester.

Tuition rates shall be established by the Center for Careers and Technology after considering collective bargaining agreements, sub-contractors, facilities, materials, and other relevant considerations.

3. Guidelines

Members of the Gold Card Club shall be entitled to enroll in most continuing education classes at a twenty-five percent (25%) reduction.

Students under eighteen (18) years of age may enroll in continuing education courses under the following conditions:

- 1. Space is available after adult registrations.
- 2. Full tuition is paid.
- 3. A parent/guardian attends with the student.
- 4. The continuing education instructor approves.
- 5. The course is noncredit bearing.

Continuing education courses may be available for workplace or community based delivery and contracts will be coordinated by the Center for Careers and Technology.
