Purpose</p> <p>Any homework assigned to students in the district shall serve one (1) or more of the following purposes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide essential practice in needed skills. 2. Reinforce independent work-study habits. 3. Provide an opportunity to increase the student’s motivation to learn. 4. Enrich and extend the in-school learning experience. 5. Develop self-discipline. 6. Bring the student into contact with school and community resources. 7. Homework will not be assigned as a form of punishment. <p>2. Guidelines Title 22 Sec. 12.2</p> <p>Each student shall be responsible for completing homework assignments as directed.</p> <p>Criteria for evaluating the quality of homework shall be based on the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Does the homework assigned serve one (1) or more of the aforementioned valid purposes? 2. Is it well within the capabilities of the student? 3. Has the student been prepared and motivated for the assigned work? 4. Does the assignment reinforce learning through practice, application, integration and/or extension of knowledge and skills? 5. Is the assignment clear and devoid of ambiguity?

Do the nature and content of the assignment preclude the need for help from parents/guardians in order that said assignment be completed in a reasonable length of time?7. Is the completed assignment able to be evaluated by the teacher?8. Can the completed assignment be used in the daily program?
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
