As you prepare submissions to Scholastic, please also consider submitting *The Barbaric YAWP*, an anthology of writing by Carlisle High School students that is professionally published and is available at Whistlestop Books and Amazon.com. Our most recent edition, *Unraveled*, can be viewed in PDF format at tinyurl.com/chsyawp2020.

Submitting your work is easy:

- Save a copy of your work <u>without your name</u> (unless it's unavoidable in the content of your piece). Please use the title of your piece as the file name
- Use a school computer\* to visit tinyurl.com/chsbarbaricyawp
- Complete the fields and upload your file

  We do NOT accept google docs or PDFs; please save a copy as a .doc or similar extension
- Please submit each individual poem, story, etc. separately

Our first submission deadline is the same as Scholastic's: Friday, **December 4**. A second submission window will open in the spring, but there are advantages to submitting early including the possibility of being invited to join the student editorial board, which reads all pieces anonymously and recommends select limited pieces for publication. NOTE: Not all submissions will be selected for publication…even those that may have been awarded Scholastic gold.

You will retain all rights to your work, but by submitting, you consent to publication in *The Barbaric YAWP* with the understanding that any profits from the sale of the book will fund future YAWP programming. All published authors will receive one free copy of the anthology.

Again, congratulations! We look forward to reading your work and hopefully providing it an outlet for wider readership.
