


Carlisle Area School District Secondary Education Summer Learning Program Handbook - 2022

SUMMER LEARNING INFORMATION

About the Remedial Summer Learning Program:

The purpose of the Summer Learning Program is to recover credit for courses that were failed during the school year. Students enrolled in the Summer Learning Program will typically take one or two courses. In some situations, students may be required to take more courses in order to meet their academic requirements or to help them recover additional credits/learning.

Summer Learning Program 2022 Dates:

Summer Learning Program will run on the following schedule:

Friday, June 10 – 8:30 AM – Report to Lamberton Middle School (Laptops and first day)

Monday, June 13 through Thursday June 16 (no sessions on Friday)

*Tuesday, June 21 through Thursday, June 23 (no sessions on Friday)

Monday, June 27 through Thursday, June 30 (no sessions on Friday)

*Tuesday, July 5 through Thursday, July 7 (no sessions on Friday)

*No Session on Monday, June 20 or Monday, July 4 in observance of holidays.

Summer Learning Program 2022 Times:

Students must attend either one or two sessions daily (based on their course requirements).

Session 1 runs from 8:30 AM to 11:00 AM

Session 2 runs from 11:30 AM to 2:00 PM

Summer Learning Program Location:

Lamberton Middle School

Summer Learning Program Format:

-Students will be enrolled in online courses to remediate courses failed during the year.

-Work will be completed on computers, on worksheets, on paper, independently, and/or at school.

-Work will be submitted either in person or online and graded as such.

-Carlisle teachers will be present to monitor progress, grade specific assignments, offer tutoring, assist with course content and answer questions.

Students **must** complete each remedial course and earn a grade of **at least 65% to pass**.

Students are expected to complete all assignments within the provided timeframe. Students may access their courses at home to either stay on track for completion, or to get ahead in their course(s). A student may successfully complete their required course(s) prior to the end of summer learning session in which case they will not be required to attend. Students will receive a written form from the principal to acknowledge the completion of the course.

Credit and Grades:

Students who successfully complete a Summer Learning Program remedial course will receive credit for the course which will count toward graduation. The transcript, however, will reflect the grade of 65%. If the student takes an alternate course to the course failed during the school year, the student may have an opportunity to earn a percentage grade reflective of 100% to 0% (these are high school elective courses only).

Attendance Requirements:

Students are expected to attend each day and to arrive promptly. Classes are in session every Monday through Thursday, June 10th through July 7th. There will be no sessions on Monday, June 20th or Monday, July 4th. Students may miss a day with a doctor's note. Extensions will **not** be granted.

Transportation:

Transportation will not be provided for the Secondary Education Summer Learning Program. Please plan your needs accordingly.

Registration:

Open - Monday, May 23, 2022 through Friday, June 10, 2022

Food and Drinks:

Breakfast is served from 8:25-8:30am and lunch will be available for students from 11:00am-11:30am.

Students may bring snacks and/or lunch if they choose.

Water bottles are strongly encouraged and water fountains will be available.

Headphones:

We strongly encourage students to bring their own headphones in order to listen to online content.

Parent/Guardian Communication:

Students and Parents/Guardians will need to provide a valid email address in order to create student and parent/guardian accounts. Parents/Guardians will be able to login at any time to see their child's progress. Parents/Guardians will receive a weekly progress email from the online provider. Formal progress reports will **not** be mailed home as both students and parents/guardians have regular access to the program to check status.

Behavior:

Students are expected to exhibit respectful behavior in relation to themselves and other students as well as any adults with whom they have contact during the Summer Learning Program. All district disciplinary policies remain in effect and failure to meet expectations will result in immediate dismissal from the program with no refund of tuition payment(s).

Please be aware that smoking on school property is grounds for immediate dismissal from the program.

Use of personal electronic device(s), including phone(s), are not permitted. Use of devices during course work and/or online assessments could be considered cheating and may result in immediate dismissal from the program.

Dress:

Appropriate attire is expected as reflected by the district dress code. Standard CASD dress code applies to the Summer Learning Program.
